## Poggio La Noce 2013 Paonazzo

### **Drinking window:**

The 2013 Paonazzo, a blend of 50% Sangiovese and 50% Colorino, is one of the best wines I have tasted from Poggio La Noce. A blast of black cherry, plum, smoke, licorice and dark spice makes a strong first impression. Beams of supporting tannin and acid give the Paonazzo its super-classic textural feel. The Sangiovese was aged in cask, while the Colorino was brought up in used French oak *barriques*. The Paonazzo is flat-out delicious today.
